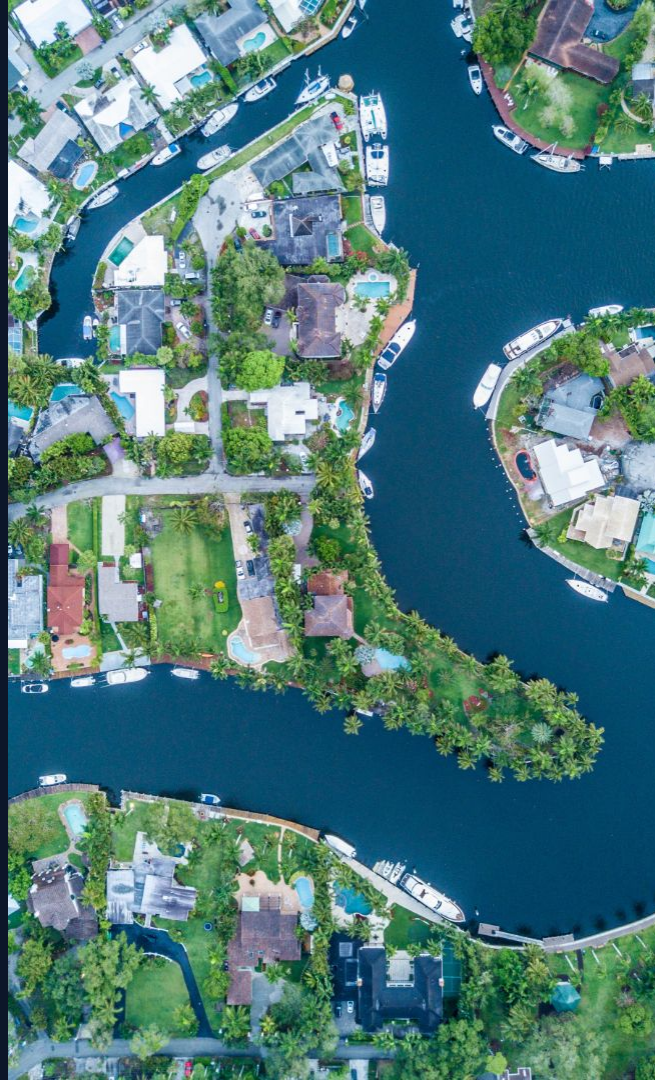

Texas stormwater management is uniquely hard.

- Rapid urbanization + more impervious cover → more runoff, faster peaks
- Aging drainage assets + limited operational capacity
- Flash floods + drought-to-flood transitions stress systems and staffing
- Compliance expectations continue (TPDES/TCEQ) regardless of staffing/budget constraints



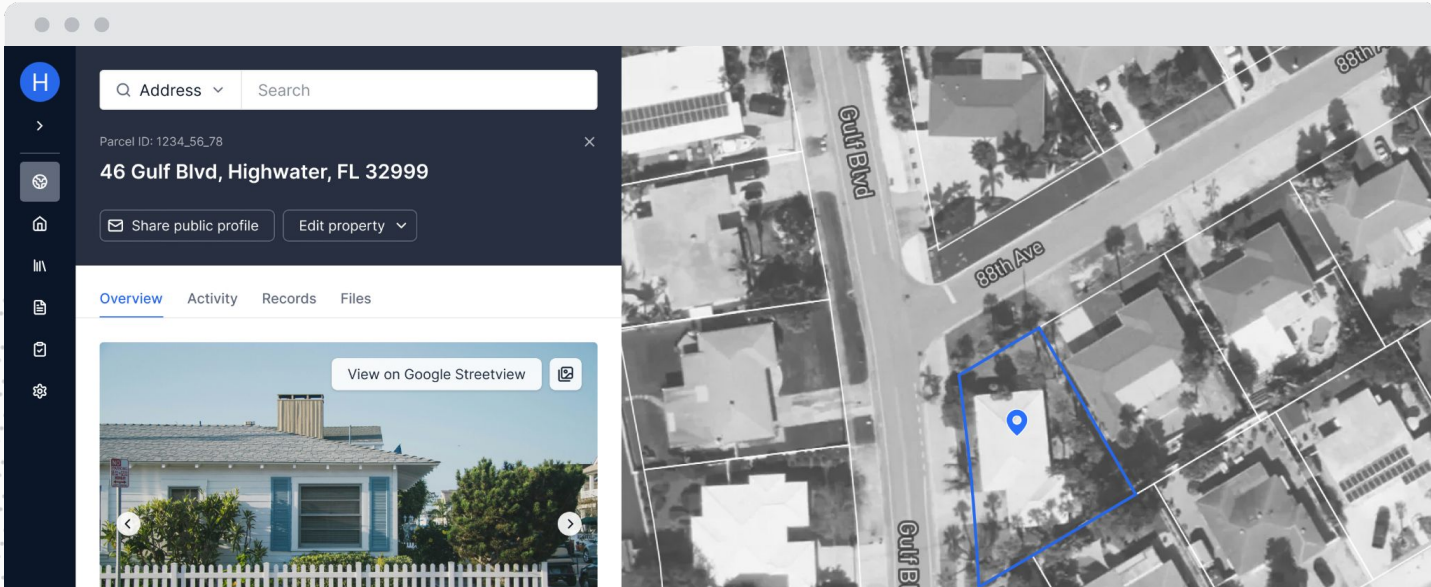
Administrative burden reduces program capacity.

- Documents stored across email, shared drives, paper binders, and legacy databases
- Hard to answer: "What's overdue?" "What's been inspected?" "Where's the latest SWPPP?"
- Field-to-office lag (photos/notes don't make it into the record cleanly)
- Reporting prep becomes a scramble: exporting, reformatting, reconciling, version control
